- No food or drink in the warehouse.
- There is no climbing, standing or sitting on any equipment, including but not limited to:
 - Pallets
 - Pallet Jacks
 - Racking
 - Forklifts
 - Tables
 - Vehicles
- Children ages 12-15 years of age must be accompanied by an adult while volunteering.
- Children less than 12 years of age are not permitted to volunteer, be unsupervised in the building or under indirect supervision while an adult is volunteering.
